The Better Jobs Ontario program supports individuals who have been laid off and are struggling to find employment through training and financial support. The program provides eligible applicants with:

- Skills training for in-demand jobs
- Financial support

Financial Support

You can apply for up to \$28,000 for costs, including:

- Tuition
- Books
- Other instructional costs, including student fees, supplies, and electronic devices
- Transportation
- A basic living allowance (up to \$500 per week)

Additional funding may be available for:

- Childcare
- Disability-related supports
- Living away from home
- Literacy and basic skills (LBS) and language training



Duration

Better Jobs Ontario aims to help participants rejoin the workforce quickly and focuses on training programs that take 52 weeks or less to complete, including micro-credential programs.
