Job Fairs

A job fair is an exhibition made up of different employers looking to fill several positions at once. Job seekers get a chance to:

- Meet representatives from various employers and different industries.
- Learn about possible employment opportunities.
- Grow your professional network.
- Gain insight into potential career choices.
- Potentially find employment.
- Practise interviewing skills.

Hiring Events

A hiring event is much like a job fair (see above), but it is for only one company that is looking to fill a number of jobs all at once, so the company chooses to have a dedicated day to interview candidates. Hiring events often require you to apply for an interview in advance, this is called prescreening, as they have limited time to see job seekers who are interested and want to be sure they see candidates that are best suited for the roles. For job seekers, it helps reduce the waiting time on the day, as selected applicants are typically given a time for their interview.
